

HOW TO DISCONNECT A ROTOCHOPPER HORIZONTAL GRINDER FROM A GENERATION II TRANSPORT DOLLY

- Always ensure proper safety protocol is followed and appropriate PPE is worn.
- Park on the most level solid ground possible, place wheel chocks on wheels.



- 3 Close the tank valve on the dolly rear tank.
- Open air bag valve, this will dump the dolly air bags.

- Disconnect light and air lines from dolly to machine. Do not hook lines up to dolly air ports at this time.

- 6 Start the machine.
- Remove the landing gear pins on both sides of the grinder and lower the landing gear to support the front of the machine. Disconnect the semi-truck from the machine, park out of the way. Raise landing gear all the way up and install landing gear pins.

- Remove the retaining bolts from the locking pins on both sides of the horizontal grinder.

- Using the hydraulic control lever located under radiator, retract the locking pins fully.

- Switch the machine to dolly mode.

- Using the wireless remote or the tether remote, track the grinder straight off the dolly.
- Make sure to clear the dolly all the way before switching off of dolly mode.


